Dear Virginia Educators and Community Members:

In June 2026, Norfolk, Hampton Roads, and Virginia's Chesapeake Bay region will welcome an international fleet of tall ships, military vessels, and character ships to commemorate America's 250th anniversary. This milestone event, **Sail250® Virginia**, will welcome more than 60 ships from 20 countries, bringing 7,000 visiting sailors, officers, and dignitaries to Virginia's shores.

Sail250® Virginia aims to foster international goodwill, inspire patriotism, and spark interest in America's rich maritime history. In the tradition of the past five iconic OpSail® maritime festivals held in Virginia since 1976, the international Sail250® Virginia fleet will once again bring extraordinary experiences and opportunities to every corner of our communities, including our Virginia schools, youth organizations and community programs.

As we approach America's 250th anniversary, we invite all Virginia educators and community organizations to take advantage of our <u>Sail250[®] Virginia education program</u>, which features three key components:

- Adopt-A-Ship Program
- Online Maritime-Themed Resources and Projects
- Educational Speaker Series

The Sail250® Virginia Adopt-A-Ship program offers student and community groups the chance to become cultural ambassadors by "adopting" one of the visiting ships. Each group will be paired with one of the visiting ships to explore its history, culture of its home country, and eventually, to correspond with its crew as they sail to Virginia in 2026! We welcome the participation of entire schools and community groups. While there is no maximum limit for the number of people involved, we do ask that one person serve as the primary point of contact for each organization.

STEPS to Become an ADOPT-A-SHIP Partner:

- 1) Visit the <u>Sail250® Virginia</u> website for updates about Affiliate Harbor Events, Ships, Educational Resources, Suggested Maritime Projects, Speaker Series and Adopt-A-Ship program ideas. Feel free to share these resources with your teachers and colleagues.
- 2) Begin planning. Meet with your group to brainstorm lesson plans, activities, or events tied to your adopted ship.
- 3) Review Confirmed Ships on our website. This list will continue to grow as more ships are confirmed.
- 4) Complete the Adopt-A-Ship Partner Registration Form which includes:
 - a. Contact information
 - **b.** Your top three preferences from the Confirmed Ship List (Norfolk only)
 - c. Outline of your areas of interest and tentative plans as an Adopt-A-Ship Partner
 - d. Estimated number and age range of participants
 - e. Interest in Transportation Grant information (Virginia schools only)
 - f. Comments/Questions
- 5) Submit your Registration Form to cookp@festevents.org

We're confident that you share our commitment to making the ships and their crews feel as welcome and at home as possible upon their arrival in Norfolk. While we will do our best to match you with one of your preferred ships, please understand that assignments are subject to change—or even cancellation--based on the schedules and

preferences of the ships and their respective nations. Rest assured; we will make every effort to notify our partners of any changes as soon as possible.

We encourage you to submit your ADOPT-A-SHIP REGISTRATION FORM at your earliest convenience, as matches will be made on a rolling basis.

Frequently Asked Questions

Which ships are eligible for the Adopt-A-Ship program?

Any confirmed ship on our website that states it will be in Norfolk, June 19-23, 2026. Keep in mind that we expect more ships and countries to confirm over the next couple months.

Are schools and organizations outside of the Hampton Roads region allowed to adopt a ship?

We welcome schools and organizations from anywhere in the Commonwealth of Virginia to participate. While it is exciting to be able to visit the ships in Norfolk, great learning experiences and relationships can be developed online and through social media.

When is the best time to submit our partner registration form?

You may submit your registration form as soon as you have some preliminary ideas and approximate numbers of participants. We understand your plans may change or evolve as the year progresses. We hope that all registrations will be received by December 15, 2025, to allow significant time for your partnerships to develop.

How soon will we know which ship we have been assigned?

We will start making matches as soon as mid-October. Ideally, all interested partners will be matched by January 2026.

Is there a charge to participate in the Adopt-A-Ship program?

Sail250® Virginia does not charge anything to participate. Your school/organization will be responsible for any expenses incurred from your plans and activities. For example, hosting a social event, supplies for learning projects, t-shirts for your participants, etc.

What is the Transportation Grant?

Funds will be available to offset transportation costs for Virginia schools who are able to bring students to visit ships in Norfolk in June 2026. More information will be provided in early 2026.

Integrate information about maritime & military history & heritage into your educational curriculum.
Host a concert featuring music from a visiting ship's country.
Create an art contest inspired by the visiting fleet or their countries.
Have students cook meals inspired by the cuisine of the visiting ship's country.
Utilize Educational Resources & Suggested Maritime Projects on Sail250® Virginia website.
Other ideas:
During the June 2026 ship visits to Norfolk:
Provide translators during Sail250® Virginia to practice your foreign language skills.
Meet visiting ships on the pier as they arrive in Norfolk.
Opportunities for select participants to tour visiting ships during the events in June 2026.
Host a dinner or cookout for the captain and crew of a visiting ship.
Host the crew of a visiting ship for a baseball or soccer game.
Organize a run/walk with the crew of a visiting ship.
Host the crew of a visiting ship for a field trip to a local museum, theme park, or shopping center.
